Bed Bug Eradication Training

Overview

The Association of Alaska Housing Authorities will host a two (2) day training in Anchorage, Alaska. Attendees will learn about the Federal and State of Alaska regulations on applicators of pesticides, including what may or may not require State certification to be obtained. A presentation on the various materials and techniques available along with the trainer's professional experience and preferences with the methods. There will be discussion regarding the safety and handling of pesticides and non-pesticide materials, both for handlers and for tenants. The program will address the IPM (Integrated Pest Management) approach which includes deciding if and when action is necessary, what action is needed, and what levels of control products should be used (and how best to decide). Various levels of actual service will be discussed and what advantage or disadvantage each has.

Trainer

Pied Piper Pest Control has been serving Alaska since 1965 and has worked with local businesses and residents from communities across Alaska. Pied Piper is a recognized member of the National Pest Management Association and a member of the bedbugFREE Network. They have partnered with Bed Bug Central to provide this training. Bed Bug Central is the nation's most authoritative information resource regarding bed bugs and the issue related to an infestation. Employing expert entomologists, that actively research, develop and test bed bug treatment protocols they have helped to spearhead effective treatment and prevention solutions.
