FEBRUARY 21-23, 2017 ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW WORKSHOP

3-day Interactive Workshop and Training

AAHA is hosting a new hands-on, three-day environmental review workshop to provide HUD recipients with the necessary skills to ensure full compliance with the requirements of 24 C.F.R. Part 50/58. Participants will become familiar with: preparing environmental review records; making environmental review determinations, identifying environmental impact; the consultation process, public notices and comment periods; and processing the request for release of funds to achieve compliance with NEPA and related laws, orders, and regulations.

The training will be facilitated by an experienced local environmental review officer with experience conducting multiple levels of environmental reviews.

Please bring a copy of an IHP (current or past) and a current rehab or new construction project description for practice purposes, if possible.

The course is designed to train staff responsible for conducting environmental reviews under HUD's 24 CFR Part 50/58 regulations.
