Overview

AAHA will be hosting this three (3) day training on Low Income Housing Tax Credit and will provide attendees with an in-depth introduction to the Low Income Housing Tax Credit Program. This class will cover the LIHTC program and how it works, determining the value of tax credits for a projects, compliance monitoring requirements, applying income limits, requirements for calculating income and how to identify lease requirements and annual recertification for the LIHTC Program. Please note this course is development focused and an Alaska specific compliance training, and is not a NTCCP Certification course.

She has worked directly with tribal housing authorities on LIHTC, NAHASDA, AHP and other affordable housing program requirements.
