Overview

AAHA will host a two (2) day training and workshop on Mold. Participants will be provided with knowledge of the physics driving the movement of heat, air and moisture associated with the formation of mold in residential buildings. Subjects will include building science, air sealing, insulation and ventilation. The first day of training will focus on the physical conditions in the buildings that can lead to mold formations and the appropriate best practices to eliminate those conditions. The second day will focus on mold identification, testing, associated health risks and effective remediation techniques.

AAHA has selected Alaska Craftsman Home Program's Jim Ward to present the training. Jim brings over 30 years of professional building and energy efficiency consulting experience to this class. He serves as subject matter expert on technical advisory and code review committees for the Municipality of Anchorage, the Cold Climate Housing Research Center and the Alaska Craftsman Home Program.
