### Overview

AAHA will host a 1 (one) day training on QuickBooks Advanced. The training will use real world examples from the US Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and Native American Housing Assistance and Self-Determination Act of 1996 (NAHASDA). The QuickBooks Advanced training will include a variety of topics including; Pre-Payment and Deposits; Classes; Job Costing; Lists; Customizing Forms; Reporting; Journal Entries and Advanced Tools.

### Trainer

Rob has more than a decade of experience providing clear, concise, and cogent solutions for housing entities, non-governmental organizations, and executives.
