## Self-Monitoring Training

### Overview

Self-Monitoring is a challenging requirement for Federal grants including the Indian Housing Block Grant. Annual monitoring is required by NAHASDA and by 2 CFR 200. Additionally self-monitoring empowers recipients to effectively manage their programs. The objective of this training is to provide participants with a sound foundation for complying with the self-monitoring requirements as well as to provide strategies and insight recipients can utilize to make self-monitoring an effective tool to accomplish their goals. This training will emphasize the development of local self-monitoring plans that are appropriate and effective for the size and needs of the recipient's program. The Uniform Administrative Requirements for Federal Awards, 2 CFR 200, have established new requirements for self-monitoring and subrecipients. The training will provide participants with the most current information on these requirements as well as the tools that are available to support recipient self-monitoring. Training participants will also receive an updated self-monitoring manual which will be a useful resource for planning and conducting self-monitoring.

### Trainer

David Vought has 38 years of experience working with Indian and Alaska Native tribes. His background includes 25 years with HUD in management positions and serving as the executive director of an Alaska Indian Housing Authority. Currently he provides training and technical assistance on a wide range of topics including administration, program development, procurement, construction administration, planning, financing, housing development, management practices and other housing related topics.
