Overview

AAHA is hosting a (3.5) day comprehensive training introduction to the roles and responsibilities of Tribal Council members with regard to the Native American Housing Assistance and Self Determination Act of 1996 (NAHASDA), with *the final half day (12/7) being optional* for participants to schedule a one-on-one session with the trainer. Topics will include an overview of NAHASDA, Conflict of Interest, Procurement, Tribal Council Roles and Responsibilities under NAHASDA, Strategic Planning, Compliance and Monitoring, Reporting and Recordkeeping, and AONAP Assistance. Other major topics to be addressed include determining eligibility and the Indian Housing Plan/Annual Performance Report. This course provides the foundation for tribal council members to be successful in applying applicable rules and policies to conflict resolution and decision-making. Case studies, group discussions, and hands-on exercises will be applied to reinforce NAHASDA concepts

Trainer

Cielo Gibson will be the trainer for this workshop. Ms. Gibson has over 20 years' experience with Indian Housing throughout the United States including Alaska. She has extensive experience as a professional trainer and administering and developing NAHASDA programs. Ms. Gibson has worked as an executive director for high-risk Indian housing authorities for over 20 years and has implemented numerous programs using low-income housing tax credits, Section 184, and ICDBG funds. She has conducted numerous tribal council and board member trainings.
