Uniform Guidance for the Administration and Financial Management of the Indian Housing Block Grant

Overview

The Uniform Guidance became effective on December 26, 2014 and establishes the administrative and financial management requirements for all Federal grants in accordance with 2 CFR 200. The Uniform Guidance requirements encompasses management standards, procurement, reporting, record keeping, allowable costs, audits and much more. In addition to the Uniform Guidance, specific program requirements are established by statute or regulation which supersedes the Uniform Guidance. The purpose of this two (2) day training is to provide a comprehensive overview of the administrative and financial management requirements for the Indian Housing Block Grant (IHBG) pursuant to the Native American Housing Assistance and Self Determination Act (NAHASDA) including the Uniform Guidance. The training will emphasize the practical application of the Uniform Guidance to the NAHASDA program requirements. Additionally resources and tools will be provided to assist recipients in complying with the Federal requirements.
