Overview

The Uniform Guidance are rules adopted by the Federal Government which apply to all Federal Awards. The Uniform Guidance became effective on December 26, 2014 and establishes comprehensive requirements pertaining to procurement, reporting, record keeping, allowed costs, audits and other administrative requirements for Federal grants. The purpose of this two (2) day training is to assist HUD/ONAP program recipients in identifying the changes enacted by the new rule and the applicability of the Uniform Guidance (2 CFR Part 200) for NAHASDA (24 CFR Part 1000) and the Indian Housing Block Grant (24 CFR Part 1003). To support Tribes/TDHEs in implementing the Uniform Guidance, the training will emphasize the practical application of the Uniform Guidance. Additionally resources and tools will be provided to assist recipients in modifying their current administrative and management systems to comply with the Uniform Guidance including policies, operating procedures, internal control processes and other administrative standards.
