Overview

Starting May 1, 2018, submission of the 2019 Indian Housing Plan/Annual Performance Report (IHP/APR) will be through the new **EPIC** on-line web reporting system or the Adobe fillable PDF version of the IHP/APR with an approved waiver.

On April 26, 2018, the Alaska Office of Native American Programs (AONAP), in conjunction with the Cook Inlet Housing Authority (CIHA), is offering a workshop for the new EPIC reporting system for the IHP/APR in the CIHA's conference room located at 3510 Spenard Road, Anchorage, AK. (**note, this is immediately following AAHA's IHP/APR training on April 24-25, 2018.*) A total of 23 seats are available for the EPIC workshop. The workshop will begin with attendee sign-in and computer setup from 8:30 to 9:00 AM with class beginning at 9:00 AM.

All attendees must **pre-register** to attend this course and sign up for EPIC access. Registered attendees will be sent instructions on how to request a user identification in Secure Systems for EPIC access. This must be completed prior to the course. Attendees need to bring a laptop computer with wireless capability or a tablet with Internet Explorer (version 11 or higher) already installed to access the EPIC system during the training. Only one computer or tablet is needed per IHP, so if two or more people are attending for the same entity, one computer can be shared during the workshop. Attendees will also need their approved 2018 or draft 2019 IHP to enter into the EPIC system as part of the workshop.

The Alaska ONAP will also be offering this class in Fairbanks and Juneau at a future date (TBA) with registration information to be provided soon.
